## Transportation Information

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What you need to know...





- **Register:** Information will be sent to you from HRCE's Transportation Team this summer
- **<u>Safety</u>** bums on seat, backpacks on lap
- <u>Behaviour</u> if there are concerns, please let us know
- <u>Routes</u> be sure to check My BusPlanner in August
- <u>Changes</u> if you are making changes to after school routines– you must send us a note. Please note that bus drivers are only able to transport students who are on their bus manifest.

# Clothing:

## Integrated Language Arts:


Primary students will have daily opportunities to develop skills in the areas of:

Teachers follow <u>Provincial guidelines</u> to develop well-balanced literacy learning opportunities.




## Integrated Math:




Students in Mathematics Primary explore the following topics:

## Specialist Classes:



• Physical Education Classes will take place 3 times a week. Proper attire on Gym days is very important!

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• Music classes will take place twice a week.



# Library:

 Students visit the Library once a week and will be able to bring books home to share and return the next week.



#### The First Day of School

- **Drop off** Try to make it as quick and positive as you can. If you are happy and excited- it is more likely that your child will be too!
- Checking in Feel free to check in with the office if you need to. We will be able to reassure you that things are going great.
- **Dismissal** Primary teachers walk their students out the side doors by the Kiss and Go Drop off Loop. If you are picking up, you can meet them there. If there are changes to your plans please let them know in writing ahead of time.
- You will hear from your child's Primary teacher early in September to welcome you to their class and give you more specific information about their classrooms.

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#### Student Support:

As parents/guardians and educators, we know, appreciate and celebrate the differences in our children. In their own way, each child is special and unique in their growth and development.

However, some children require some assistance with communication (speech, language development, hearing), being able to focus for longer periods of time, safety issues, personal care or just making it through a busy day's schedule without stress or confusion.

There are times that many children can seem to fall into one or more of those categories. But if your child consistently needs support, is on medication, or you are working with physicians or thinking of going to a physician to explore the special needs that your child may have, please let us know asap.

We want to work with you to best support your child at school.
