<p>SAC contributed to the development of the school safety matrix, giving feedback on the original draft and supporting a feedback form shared with the school community.</p> <p>SAC drafted a letter to local MLA and Education minister to better understand provincial cuts and budget implications in the education system, with hopes of an MLA attending a SAC meeting in the 2026/27 school year.</p>

SAC approved the purchase of “We Thinkers” kit to support social competencies and life skills, as well as Powerful Writing Structures, a webinar resource for teachers to support student literacy.
