Student Success Planning	 We have met with all of our PLC's and have begun gathering / assessing data to inform our short cycle planning. Resource support will be determined based on data and will take place in short cycle intervals. All classes have been focusing on building relationships and getting to know students since the beginning of September. Based on our data from last year's Student Success Survey approximately 50% of our students felt that their teachers did not know what their lives were like outside of school. We are working on that this year. 52% of our students also identified that they often find it harder to pay attention in class - so we continue to work on strategies to increase engagement (ie. whiteboard tables in P/1M)
