Colder weather is here and it is very important that students come dressed to be outside in all types of weather. Decisions on whether to send students outside at recess and lunch are always made on a day to day basis, however, here are some guidelines for you to consider:

- If it is damp day and there is a light mist—we will still try to get outside if possible
- If it is warmer than –10 we will most likely be going outside
- If it is between -10 and -15 we may go outside but it could be for shorter periods of time
- If it is colder than –15 we most likely will not be outside for recess and lunch, but individual teachers may take students out for a few minutes to get some fresh air.
